### ***Get to know me...***

1. If you were one of the apostles and you went back to the future to visit Cornerstone, what do you think would be the weirdest thing about our Church?
2. What from the sermon stuck with you? Was there anything you didn't understand or disagreed with?

### ***Getting into the Bible:***

3. Read Acts 4:1-7. Why do you think the Jewish leaders were so disturbed by the healing of the lame beggar and the Apostles teaching?
  - What kind of people today would you relate to the Jewish leaders?
  - If we are honest, what are some ways we can relate to the Jewish leaders?
4. Read Acts 4:8-12. What strikes you about Peter's response to the questioning of the Jewish leaders?
5. Read Acts 4:13-21. With all the evidence laid out before them, why do you think the Jewish leaders still refused to validate the miracle and message of Peter and John?
6. Just for fun: Why do you think it was important for Luke to include John in this story even though he never seems to do or say anything?

7. How does this passage apply to you today?
8. On Sunday Logan said, "we must never stop reaching, leaping, and preaching for Jesus." How can you apply this challenge to your life this week?
